**Recipe of the Month  
Banana Pudding**

**Ingredients:**

- ½ box of vanilla wafers      3-4 bananas
- 1-2 packages of banana instant pudding
- 1 package of vanilla or cheesecake instant pudding
- 1 small container of sour cream (4oz)    1 regular container of Cool Whip (8oz)

**Directions:**

- Mix up pudding according to box directions
- Mix in sour cream
- Mix in half container of cool whip
- Line bowl with vanilla wafer & banana slices
- Pour half of mixture into wafer & banana lined bowl
- Top with banana slices
- Spread rest of cool whip over the top
- Crumble vanilla wafers on top
- Refrigerate before serving
